El Húsar de la Muerte (The Hussar of Death), made in 1925 by Pedro Sienna, is a milestone in Latin American filmmaking. It recounts the deeds and adventures of Manuel Rodríguez, patriot and hero of the Chilean Independence War, around which a love story develops. The film surprises for its directness, artful editing and blend of humour, brutality and historical daring.



El Húsar will be publicly shown for the first time in Italy as one of the Special Events at the XXV Giornate del Cinema Muto (aka: Pordenone Silent Film Festival), with the music by Horacio Salinas (director of the legendary group Inti-Illimani) performed live by the ensemble VIVA6. Thanks to the support of the Instituto Cervantes, this event has been presented in several European film festivals in 2005-06.
